Property owners affected by the recent flooding events in Renfrew County are invited to attend this Public Information Session. The purpose of this Information Session is for residents to obtain information on Disaster Recovery Assistance for Ontarians (DRAO) Program and Support Services for Renfrew County Residents Affected by the Spring 2017 Flooding.

A representative from the **Ministry of Municipal Affairs** will provide an overview of the Disaster Recovery Assistance for Ontarians (DRAO) program that provides funding to eligible homeowners (primary residence only) and residential tenants, small owner operated businesses and farms and not-for-profit organizations that have been affected by the flooding event.

The **Canadian Red Cross** will also be present to provide an overview of the services they can offer and their assistance program for those impacted by the flooding.

Additional resource material will also be available from other agencies to help assist in the clean-up and recovery stages.
