They can only go back to work when they receive a negative test result AND it has been 24 hours since symptoms started improving AND they have not had a fever (without medication) for 24 hours”, however, the same document stated “If a child with major symptoms OR multiple minor symptoms OR an adult with any symptoms does not get tested, they must self-isolate for 14 days from the onset of symptoms”. The Committee was asked to review these statement on their own and email their interpretation to Lindsey Lee by the end of day for review. Based on the Committee’s overall interpretation and opinions, it would then be decided by the Committee if an updated Policy should be brought forward to Council.
