Please ensure leaf and yard waste is at the curb before 7:30 a.m. on the Monday of the scheduled week.
Pickup will take place throughout the week and may not correspond with your regular garbage collection schedule

CONTAINERS & SIZING

Biodegradable paper bags or in bundles that meet the following requirements. Individual containers must not exceed 23kg (50lbs), trimmed branches must not exceed 25mm (1.0 inch) in diameter, bundles must not exceed 1.5m (5 feet) in length and 0.6m (2 feet) in diameter.

## LIVING IN THE COUNTRY

Learn how the Farming and Food Protection Act protects "normal farm practice" in Ontario and how conflicts, nuisances and bylaws are handled.

Rural Ontario is changing. Farms are increasing in size and complexity, and fewer people living in rural areas are farmers.

To ensure the rights of all rural Ontario residents are respected, the Ontario government passed Bill 146, the Farming and Food Production Protection Act, 1998 (FFPPA),



There are two main themes in the FFPPA:

- Farmers are protected from nuisance complaints made by neighbours, provided they are following "normal farm practices."
- No municipal bylaw applies to restrict a "normal farm practice" carried on as part of an agricultural operation.

#### Garbage and Recycling Calendar: April 2024 to March 2025



Garbage Collection	
Hours	Please ensure garbage and recycling are roadside by 7:30 a.m. on collection day.
Limit	A maximum of 2 regular-sized garbage bags are allowed each week. Bag size is 26" x 32½" or equivalent containers of 67 litres each week. A yellow tag must be attached to each extra bag and placed at the curb.
Extra Tags	Additional yellow tags can be purchased for \$2.00 each*. Tags may be purchased at the Township Office, White Lake General Store or Antrim Truck Stop.

Hours	Open Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday 8:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.
Fees*	Household & Construction Material: \$90.00/tonne*. Items that can be disposed of at the Landfill free of charge include: Electronic Waste • Leaf and Yard Waste • Clean Wood Waste (no stumps) • and Scrap Metal.
Tires	Up to 10 tires, with or without rims, per residential property per day can be disposed of free of charge at the McNab/Braside Landfill Site, visit www.rpra.ca/programs/tires for more information.
Recycling	Residents are encouraged to utilize the curbside collection for recyclable materials. For properties that do not have access to curbside collection, a recycling depot is available at the Township Landfill site. Please ensure items are sorted into correct bins and are not in plastic bags.

Limits	Acceptable Household Hazardous Waste Material: Paint and Stains • Varnish • Turpentine • Disinfectants • Household Cleaners • Furniture Stripper • Ammonia • Herbicides, Pesticides and Insecticides • Pool Cleaners • Propane Tanks • Oil and Brake Fluid • Oil Filters • Gasoline • Anti-freeze • Small Home Batteries • Car/Boat Batteries

#### Leaf and Yard Waste Pickup

Please ensure leaf and yard waste is at the curb before 7:30 a.m. on the **Monday** of the scheduled week. Pickup will commence throughout the week, and may not correspond with your regular garbage schedule.

The leaf and yard waste collection weeks are identified with a Green symbol on the above calendar.

Approved Leaf and Yard Waste containers and sizing: Biodegradable paper bags or in bundles that meet the following requirements. Individual containers must not exceed 23kg (50lbs), trimmed branches must not exceed 25mm (1.0 inch) in diameter, bundles must not exceed 1.5m (5 feet) in length and 0.6m (2 feet) in diameter.

Leaf and Yard Waste can also be brought to the Township Landfill located at 573 Calabogie Road for no additional charge.
